Double and joint degrees

- 169 universities (22%) have **double degree programs** in 2016.
 - 3,750 int'l students and 729 Japanese students obtained such degrees.

- Only a handful of universities offer **joint degree programs**.
 - Short history (legalized in 2014)
 - Operational or logistical complications including a required MEXT approval
- **Twining programs** in STEM with HEIs in developing countries (under aid and assistance programs)



Issues and challenges for Japanese unis. as a provider (sending/outgoing)

- Laws and regulations do not take account of Japanese unis' IPPM
 - Branch campus and off-shore program: must be part of the main campus
 - Must be self-owned campus and buildings
 - Rigid control of authorized enrollment quotas: No excess, No deficiency, a few seats for transfer students
 - Program offered by a Japanese uni. but run by a foreign corporation -> A Japanese degree cannot be conferred.
 - A tuition cannot be raised to make a profit overseas.
- Resource management and faculty who can teach courses in English
- Risk-averse culture
- No business-oriented (entrepreneur) model (good practice)
